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Successful Insurance Claims Processing

Up to 90 percent of revenue in a healthcare provider's practice flows through third-party payers. How much of it is hanging in limbo due to denials? Make sure that your dollars are flowing in the right direction. The window to appeal a denied claim is getting smaller; expedite your claims and appeals and get paid. Using Modifiers to Improve Claim Accuracy

Federal, state and private payers report that incorrect use of modifiers is among the top reasons for billing errors. Modifier usage is an effective way to document the complete patient story and increase communication between providers and payers to report special circumstances with patients.
