On October 1, the newly-released updates to the ICD-10-CM code set will go into effect. Don't let improperly coded claims break your revenue cycle!



Prepare your providers to correctly document to support the 2024 ICD-10-CM code updates.

There are 74,044 ICD-10-CM codes available for use in FY 2024, 395 new, 13 revised, 25 deleted codes. Many specialties are affected. It is risky to rely on EMR code selection, and failure to code to the highest degree of specificity negatively affects reimbursement and utilization statistics. Advance preparation will ensure your coding staff and providers understand the new codes, requirements, and impact on your claims. Participants will learn how to identify templates or documents to update and/or replace, integrate new codes and review general and chapter-specific ICD-10 coding and reporting guidelines for patient encounters occurring on or after October 1.

Avoid claim interruptions and ensure that your documentation supports the 2024 updates. Medical coders, billers, providers, managers, consultants, and compliance officers will review hundreds of changes to tabular instructions, updates to the general and chapter-specific guidelines for coding, and reporting patient encounters through 9/30/24.

Digital materials are provided. Registrants will receive an email with a link to download the materials approximately 2 days before the training event. An ICD-10-CM code set manual may be helpful to best comprehend the context of the revisions that will be discussed.
